

This 4-room BTO HDB apartment is a calm oasis fashioned with blue and grey hues. The bright turquoise recessed niche lends a vibrant yet casual vibe to the space. The playful addition of geometric printed artworks and pillow throw covers inspired by Terrazzo finishes the overall look.

Soothing colours are always a good idea for a dental clinic to allow patients to relax while waiting. Light toned wood is used for the counter at the reception area, topped with a quirky hanging light over the counter.

In the treatment room, a special ceiling screen is installed for patients to watch videos and be at ease during any procedures. Custom made cabinets were built in each room to ensure sufficient storage space for treatment materials.







The X-ray room is well protected with lead insulation in the wall partitions to keep both staff and patients safe. The setup required an extensive sourcing of material and experienced floor space planning to ensure safety standards were met.
